Dr. Maya Hammoud, M.D.

Dr. Hammoud is the J. Robert Willson Research Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Professor of Learning Health Sciences at the University of Michigan Medical School where she also serves as Associate Chair for Education and Chief of Women's Health Division. She holds many leadership roles nationally. She is past president and on Board of Directors of the Association of Professors of Gynecology and Obstetrics (APGO) and is a member of the Executive Board of the National Board of Medical Examiners (NBME). She is also Senior Advisor for Medical Education Innovation at the American Medical Association (AMA) and was named Crain's Notable Women in Health in 2020.

Janice Holdinski

Ms. Holdinski is a district vice president for the American Arbitration Association (AAA) primarily responsible for business development activities in the labor and employment area. She is directly involved with the recruitment of neutrals as determined by caseload needs and user preferences, and development of educational and training programs - which include advocacy training and webinars - and she administers and conducts elections, manages large, complex cases, and provides oversight for the Michigan Regional office. She has lectured at law firms, bar associations, trade groups and universities on various subjects related to the arbitration and mediation process



Dr. Rafina Khateeb MD, MBA, SFHM

Dr. Khateeb is the Associate Medical Director for Trinity Affiliates, for the University of Michigan Medical Group (UMMG) comprised of more than 2,000 physicians and health professionals in 20 clinical specialties practicing in inpatient and outpatient settings, and at affiliated health systems throughout the state of Michigan. In this role, Dr. Khateeb acts as the clinical liaison facilitating the growth of collaborations between Michigan Medicine and regional Trinity facilities to better serve patients in our community.



Hon. Cynthia Stephens

Judge Stephens served as a judge on the Michigan First District Court of Appeals and the Michigan Court of Claims. This role is in addition to her appellate court duties. Throughout her career, Judge Stephens also served as vice-chair of the Wayne County Charter Commission, associate general counsel to the Michigan Senate, regional director for the National Conference of Black Lawyers' Atlanta office, and a consultant to the National League of Cities Veterans Discharge Upgrade Project before her first judicial election. In 1981, she was elected to the 36th District Court, and in 1985, she was appointed to the Wayne County Circuit Court. She remained on the circuit court until 2008, when she was appointed to the Michigan Court of Appeals.
